The Warm Shop is a busy, dynamic place. Please keep the following guidelines in mind and help us create the best experience possible.

The Warm Shop is open during class and scheduled Open Studio, and rental times arranged in advance. Please do not drop in; distractions interrupt the work flow.

FIRING

Class projects take priority, followed by work made in our Youth Program and in Make-Your-Owns. Work made off-site will be fired as kiln loads and firing schedules allow.

The complexity of custom work will also determine how soon a piece is ready.

DO NOT OPEN KILNS

You risk ruining your own or someone else's work.

CLEAN UP WHEN YOU ARE DONE

All projects should be clearly labeled and put away on racks, leaving the tables open for the next group. Leaving work out will not get it fired more quickly.

Our goal is to offer a safe space, conducive to creativity and productivity, where artists of all ages and abilities feel welcome.

Please be respectful of other people's work (refrain from offering a critique unless you are invited to do so) and mindful of other people's work habits.
